Application Process

Parents/Guardians interested in having their children considered for entrance into the LESD Traditional Academy Program will need to complete an application for each child seeking admittance into the program. The applications will be available on February 10, 2022 and should be dropped off at the District Office, 272 E. Sagebrush St., Litchfield Park. **The Traditional Academy application deadline is April 15, 2022.** Applications will be accepted after this date to fill any slots that still remain.

Parents/Guardians of children who will be new to the program in first-fifth grade for the 2022-2023 school year, will be notified May 12-20, 2022 **via email**.

Students who qualify, but are not accepted due to space, will be placed on a waitlist. Upon availability in the program, applications will be analyzed with consideration to assessment data, priority level, student and parent input, and teacher feedback when applicable.

Questions regarding the LESD Traditional Academy Program can be referred to the campus principal or the office of the Director of Curriculum and Professional Development during the summer.

Application Instructions

Please fill out the following application in its entirety. All information will be used in determining student placement.

- 1. The first page is the application page. Please make sure to include your email address. You will be notified by email whether or not your child has been accepted into the Traditional Academy Program. All address and boundary information provided on your child's application will be verified.
- 2. Part 1 is the parent/guardian questionnaire to be filled out by parent/guardian.
- 3. Part 2 is for your child to complete.
 - a. If your child will be a first or second grader for the 2022-2023 school year, please have them fill out Part 2A (self-portrait). This is optional for third-fifth grade students.
 - b. If your child will be a third grader, fourth grader, or fifth grader for the 2022-2023 school year, please have them fill out Part 2B. This is optional for first and second grade students.
- 4. Teachers will receive an electronic teacher questionnaire. Out-of-district applicants, please provide a teacher email address in the space provided on the application or email Mandy Greene at greenem@lesd.k12.az.us with the teacher's email address. A link to the survey will be emailed directly to the out-of-district teacher.

Once you and your child have completed the application page and parts 1 and 2, please submit to the Litchfield Elementary School District Office, 272 E. Sagebrush St., Litchfield Park, AZ 85340 by **Friday, April 15, 2022**.

All applications will be evaluated. Qualifying applicants will be sorted according to priority listed in the LESD Traditional Academy Program Guide and given to the appropriate school sites. School site administrators will analyze applications with consideration to assessment data, priority level, student and parent input, and teacher feedback when applicable.
