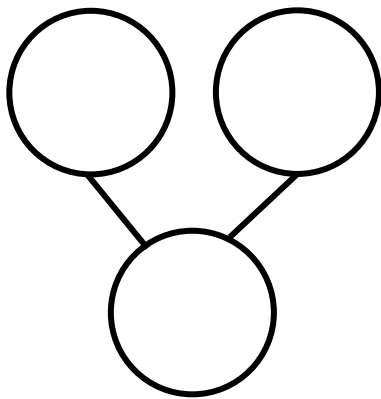
There were 9 lunch bags. 3 bags were thrown away. How many bags are there now?

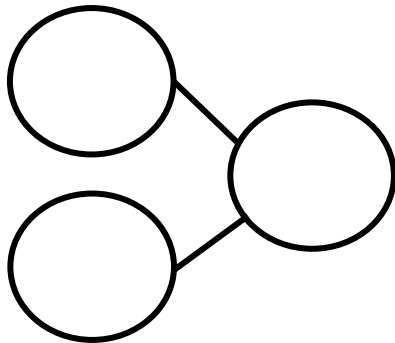
Make a 5-group drawing to show the story. Cross off the part that goes away. Fill in the number bond and number sentence.
